## Reduced UKRI-ODA budget to impact 2021/22 funding

As outlined in the <u>DVC Desk on 16 March 2021</u> and by the <u>United Kingdom Research and Innovation (UKRI)</u>, Official Development Assistance (ODA) funding for the 2021/22 financial year has been reduced due to COVID-19-related financial pressures in the UK. The <u>UKRI-ODA assistance letter</u> provides more details for those who are currently funded by UKRI councils. The <u>UKRI has also released a Q&A</u> in response to the budget cuts and a <u>virement guidance</u> and template for ODA award holders.

To date, confirmed funding opportunities that have been suspended are:

- UK MRC Applied global health research: improve health in low- and middle-income countries
- UKRI Global Challenges Research Fund (GCRF) Digital Innovation for Development in Africa (DIDA) Phase 2

The National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) has released the following statement and the NIHR Global Health Research funding calls remain open, including the Third call for applications: UK National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) Global Health Research Groups.
